Let's Explore - Printing with our Handmade Stencils & Blocks on Fabric and Paper

Explore ways of using our printing blocks and stencils. Bring along your stencils and printing blocks and experiment with them. Try monoprints, layering of prints, blocking out of sections, repeat printing etc.

What to bring

This is a list of possible equipment and materials to bring. Just bring what you already have in your stash.

- stencils and printing blocks
- printing plate/s A4 or bigger – e.g. piece of acrylic sheet (Perspex), thinner more flexible acrylic sheet, silicone mat, glass cutting board (made for use in kitchens), cardboard or foam core covered with aluminium foil or craft foam sheets
- paint – acrylic, fabric, water colour
- oil sticks
- rollers, brushes
- spoons, paint and water containers
- gloves, apron
- scissors
- cloth for wiping clean plates and equipment
- stamp pad
- variety of paper – e.g. pages from old books, textured paper, photocopy paper, tissue paper
- variety of fabric – natural and manmade fibres
- plastic sheet to protect work area
- plastic sheet to place your prints to dry
- examples of any printing you may have done
